

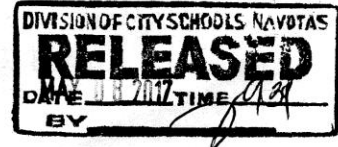

Greetings of Peace!

The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) will be holding the **National Seminar-Workshop on the Magna Carta for Public School Teachers, Public Sector Unionism and Human Rights Education: A Teachers' Summer Camp** on May 25-27 at Aringay Central Elementary School, Division of La Union. With the theme "**Rights and Responsibilities for Teacher and Child-Friendly Schools**" the seminar aims to deepen the understanding of teachers and school administrators on their rights and responsibilities and their role in promoting Human Rights Education.

The specific objectives of the seminar are:

1. To equip the teacher-leaders and school heads with knowledge on Magna Carta for Public School Teachers and the public sector unionism
2. To formulate policy recommendations on teachers' organizations
3. To facilitate the formation of teachers' organizations in the grassroots
4. To support the Department's mandate to teach human rights and popularize the rights-based approach in teaching

Teacher-leaders, heads of teachers' organizations and school heads are invited to attend this seminar. Some 300 participants from all over the country, who shall be divided into several interaction groups, are expected to participate to this event. A minimum contribution of P1, 500.00 shall be charged to each participant to cover cost of food, accommodation, kit, and other incidental expenses. The TDC in coordination with local DepEd offices opted to use some of DepEd facilities for lesser expenses and ensure wider range of participation.

In this light, we would like to request for a memorandum from your office endorsing this activity to the respective schools division superintendents and school heads of the Region. Furthermore, we would also like to request that the registration and transportation expenses be charged against the MOOE or any available local funds.

To regulate the number of participants, we shall send the list of expected attendees to your office on May 3, 2017. **The deadline for the submission of names of participants to TDC Secretariat shall be on May 1 and the deadline for pre-registration to confirm participation will be on May 15.**

Registration and billeting at Aringay Central Elementary School will start at 1:00PM of the first day, May 25 (PM snacks will be served) to be followed by the opening program at 2:00PM. Closing program at a nearby beach resort will be at 12:00NN of the 3rd day, May 27 (lunch will be served). Expenses for food and accommodation beyond those period shall be shouldered by the participants.
