- Found 3/4" rebar L.S. 3184 per M.C.R. D2.31, Pg. 65, M.C.R.
- Found iron pin L.S. 3184 in place of L.S. 1880 tag in concrete per M.C.R. D2.31, Pg. 65, M.C.R.

- L.S. Record data per 1998-20756, M.C.R.

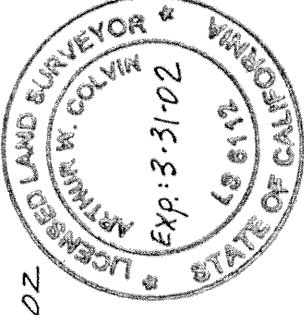
